

RoHS and WEEE Statement, for EU and UK Legislation

This statement is regarding the applicability of Spirax Sarco Ltd.'s (SSL) electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) products to the following directives and regulations:

- The RoHS Directive, 2011/65/EU, regulates the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) placed on the EU market.
 The UK legislation equivalent is SI 2012 No. 3032.
- The WEEE Directive, 2012/19/EU, regulates the treatment, recovery, and disposal of waste electrical and electronic equipment.
 The UK legislation equivalent is SI 2013 No. 3113.

SSL has assessed its EEE products against the scope of the RoHS and WEEE directives, as well as the equivalent UK legislation, identifying that Spirax Sarco EEE products are exempt from both directives and their UK equivalents. This is because our EEE products are classified as "large-scale fixed installations" (LSFIs) as per the legislative definitions below:

- RoHS, 2011/65/EU: Article 3(4).
 UK RoHS, SI 2012 No. 3032: Schedule 1 part 2 paragraph 16.
- WEEE, 2012/19/EU: Article 3(1)(c). UK WEEE, SI 2013 No. 3113: part 1 article 2.

LSFIs do not apply to these directives and regulations, as specified in the following:

- RoHS, 2011/65/EU: Article 2(4)(e).
 UK RoHS, SI 2012 No. 3032: schedule 1 part 2 paragraph 16.
- WEEE, 2012/19/EU: Article 2(4)(c) and Article 2(3)(b).
 UK WEEE, SI 2013 No. 3113: part 2 article 8(c).

Spirax EEE Products are LSFI because they are specifically designed to be installed into a part of a large-scale stationary industrial tool such that they can fulfil their function only if they are part of that large-scale stationary industrial tool and can be replaced only by the same specifically designed equipment.
