

RoHS and WEEE Directives Statement (EU)

RoHS 2011/65/EU covers electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) placed on the EU market.

WEEE 2012/19/EU covers the requirements in disposal of waste from EEE (WEEE) placed on the EU market

Spirax has assessed these directives with respect to its own business, and has determined that neither apply to Spirax products and packages ("Spirax EEE Products") for the following reasons:

Spirax EEE Products are exempt because they are specifically designed, and are installed, as part of a large-scale stationary industrial tool, they can fulfil their function only if they are part of that large-scale stationary industrial tool, and they can be replaced only by the same specifically designed equipment.

Alternatively, to the extent the above exemption does not apply, Spirax EEE Products would fall into a second exemption, as they are specifically designed, and are to be installed, as part of a large-scale fixed installations, they can fulfil their function only if they are part of that large-scale fixed installation, and they can be replaced only by the same specifically designed equipment.
