## WARNING

HIGH PRESSURE AND HOT LIQUID SPRAYS CAN CAUSE SERIOUS BODILY INJURY.

| NEVER   | <ul> <li>Never allow children or unauthorized personnel to handle equipment.</li> <li>Never put your hand or fingers in front of nozzle.</li> <li>Never point nozzle at your body — or anyone else.</li> <li>Never leave hosedown station unattended without releasing pressure.</li> <li>Never use mechanical means to hold trigger in open position.</li> </ul>  |

| BEFORE spraying and during spraying  ALWAYS                     | <ul> <li>Before pulling trigger hold nozzle firmly.</li> <li>Adopt a proper body stance to anticipate high recoil force by spray nozzle.</li> <li>Exercise care and caution when spraying.</li> <li>When spraying hot liquids avoid hand or body contact with non-insulated parts of the nozzle.</li> <li>Wear protective clothing including heavy-duty insulated gloves, boots, aprons and safety glasses.</li> </ul> |
|   | Stop spraying before becoming fatigued.  |
| BEFORE removing nozzle — OR — attempting service or maintenance | <ul> <li>1. Shut off steam and water supplies.</li> <li>2. Discharge contents of hose and nozzle to eliminate pressure.</li> <li>3. Reference section 3.3 of IM-8-002-US for proper shutdown procedures.</li> </ul>  |

- Follow the manufacturer's recommendations for maximum pressures, periodic cleaning, maintenance and parts replacement procedures.
- Do not operate the equipment if there are any leaks from spray nozzle, fittings, or hoses. High pressure leaks can penetrate the skin causing serious injury.
